

When handling sacks from a proper working height

Here you will find good advice on how to best lift sacked goods in a specially arranged sales area.



Ensure plenty of space in the work area. There should be at least one metre free space between car and pallet.



Stand close to and straight in front of the sack to be picked up.



Get a good hold with both hands and pull the sack close to your body.



Keep your back straight and lift by stretching your knee and hip joints.



Get close to the car. Slightly bend knee and hip joints. Put down the sack close to your body and roll it into place.



Use a suitable technical aid whenever possible.

Remember!

- ▶ Park to allow plenty of space in the work area. You need at least one metre between car and pallet.
- Lift close to and straight in front of your body.
- ▶ Keep your nose and shoe toes in the same direction to avoid twisting your back.
- Avoid carrying the sack more than two metres.
- ▶ Put down the sack close to your body and roll it into place.
- Use a technical aid whenever possible.
