When handling large heavy plates

Here you will find good advice on how to best handle large heavy plates.



Insert a metal wedge in one corner to separate the required number of plates from the stack.



Separate the plates by pushing the wedge further in using the forks of the truck.



Use one fork to slightly lift the stack from the underlying plates.



Move the wedge to the centre and lower the stack of plates until they rest on the wedge.

Now you can squeeze the forks in between the required number of plates and the rest of the stack and lift them clear of the stack.



It will facilitate your work if it has been agreed in advance that returned plates must be placed on battens.

Remember!

- Assess and plan the task to reduce physically straining work.
- Make sure there is plenty of space in the work area.
- Avoid lifting heavy and unhandy items.
- Always use a suitable technical aid whenever possible.
- Agree with the customer to place returned plates on battens.
